

They concentrated on Boxes QQ – Charity Commissioners. This consists of ledgers, minutes & cuttings about the various charities that existed in North Collingham e.g. Hart's Charity (1699), Lesiter's (1873), Turner's (1769) etc.

## **Collingham in the Great War**

Helena Pielichaty's research on Collingham during the Great War continued with accounts of events from 1915, published in the January & February Fleet. Helena also collaborated with Trevor Frecknall on his book: 'Collingham and district in The Great War'. This was published in September and launched at All Saints Church, Collingham on Sept 14th.

The book is a significant addition to Collingham's history, as it not only includes accounts of those who fought but also provides a chronological snapshot of what villagers were doing at the time. Copies on sale at Collingham Post Office at £9.99
